PRIVACY POLICY

Tolera Therapeutics, Inc. (“Tolera”) takes your privacy seriously. Please read the following to learn more about our privacy policy.

1. WHAT THIS PRIVACY POLICY COVERS

A. General. This policy covers how Tolera treats personal information that Tolera collects and receives, including information related to your past use of Tolera products and services. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, e-mail address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.

B. Companies Not Controlled. This policy does not apply to the practices of companies that Tolera does not own or control, or to people that Tolera does not employ or manage.

2. INFORMATION COLLECTION AND USE

A. General

1. Collection. Tolera collects personal information when you visit Tolera pages or the pages of certain Tolera partners, and when you request information. Tolera may combine information about you that we have with information we obtain from business partners or other companies.

2. Right to refrain from giving information. You have the right to refrain from giving us certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of all of our features. We use the information that you provide for to enhance the service, such as responding to your requests. However, you may not mask your identity by providing false or misleading information. For example, you may not use IP masking to mask your Internet access location, including without limitation, proxy servers, masking software or the like.

3. IP Address and Cookies. Tolera automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, Tolera cookie information, and the page you request. Most web browsers have the ability to accept cookies, reject cookies, or to prompt the user before accepting them. The help portion of the toolbar of your browser will tell you how to select the option that suits you best. However, disabling the acceptance of cookies will not allow you to take full advantage of some of the best and most advanced features that we have to offer, and we recommend that you leave them turned on.

4. Web Beacons. Tolera may use web beacons to access Tolera cookies inside and outside our network of websites and in connection with Tolera products and services.

5. Software. During some visits we may use software tools such as JavaScript to measure and collect session information, including page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page.

6. Use. Tolera uses information for the following general purposes: to customize the advertising and content you see, fulfill your requests for information, improve our services, contact you, conduct research, and provide anonymous reporting for internal and external clients.

B. Information Sharing and Disclosure

1. Sharing of Personal Information. Tolera does not rent, sell, or share personal information about you with other people or nonaffiliated companies except when we have your permission, or under the following circumstances:

(a) We provide the information to trusted partners who work on behalf of or with Tolera under confidentiality agreements. These companies may use your personal information to help Tolera communicate with you about offers from Tolera and our marketing partners. However, these companies do not have any independent right to share this information.

(b) We respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims;

(c) We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of Tolera's terms of use, or as otherwise required by law; and

(d) We transfer information about you if Tolera is acquired by or merged with another company. In this event, Tolera will provide notice before such information about you is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

2. Ad Targeting. Tolera does not display targeted advertisements.

3. CHILDREN UNDER AGE 16

It is Tolera's firm policy to not knowingly collect, solicit, retain or display any personal information or material from anyone under the age of 16. If you are under the age of 16 send any information to Tolera. No one under age 16 may provide any personal information to or on Tolera. In the event that we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under age 16 without verification of parental consent, we will promptly delete that information. 4. COOKIES

A. Rights Reserved. Tolera may set and access Tolera cookies on your computer.

B. This Policy Not Applicable to Other Companies. Tolera lets other companies that show advertisements on some of our pages set and access their cookies on your computer. Other companies' use of their cookies is subject to their own privacy policies, not this one. Advertisers or other companies do not have access to Tolera's cookies.

5. YOUR PREFERENCES

A. General

1. Requests for Information. You may request, in writing to the address provided in Section 7, access to any information collected as part of your Tolera account and Tolera will address your request within thirty (30) days of such request.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY AND SECURITY

A. Limited Access to Information. We limit access to personal information about you to employees who we believe reasonably need to come into contact with that information to provide information to you or in order to do their jobs.

B. Federal Compliance. We have physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect personal information about you. The Federal Trade Commission and the U.S. Federal Courts have jurisdiction to hear any claims against the organization regarding possible unfair or deceptive practices and violations of laws or regulations governing privacy

C. SSL-Encryption. In certain areas Tolera uses industry-standard SSL-encryption to protect data transmissions.

7. CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY

A. Updates to the Policy. Tolera may update this policy from time to time. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the primary e-mail address specified in your Tolera account or by placing a prominent notice on our site.
